

Important Assertion/Reason of Geography

While answering Assertion-Reason questions, always read both statements carefully and judge them separately. Check if the **Assertion is true**, and then see if the **Reason is also correct on its own**. If both are true, think whether the Reason **logically explains** the Assertion. But remember, if the **Assertion is false**, the Reason can't be its explanation even if it is true. These questions test your **concept clarity and logical thinking**, so don't just guess—a **proper reading of the NCERT book is very important** to answer them correctly.
